**"The Show, & Auctions, just get better"**

**Sunday** Any show organiser appreciates the occasional compliment, after the early moans & groans, and the above accolade is both a pleasure to hear from a visitor, and testament to the hard work the regular BBR team endure over an always frantic w/e. After the lengthy (*staff often say "draining"*) Saturday auction the Sunday comes round all too soon. I'm usually in the office for 5.30/6am ready to greet any "*over enthusiastic/ too early*" arrivals (*whom I must move on to avoid disturbing local residents*) stallholders are jostled onto the Heritage Centre and lined up already for unloading into Blg 21 whilst EE tickets are distributed outside the Market for swift and efficient site entrance bang on the allotted times. By the time the auction begins at 11am weariness is fast encroaching... & then the major tidy up as everyone else drives homebound!

Another 'rock solid' sale, well supported with Elsecar regulars, combined with **LIVE** online bidders, & the usual 'highs'/ unexpected bargains mixed in. *Below a small selected 'resume', with 'add-ons' giving actual costs:*

**Pot lids:** Still the "buzzing" collecting category - the delightful/ busy 3 girls Sanoline pictorial heading this range at £2,240, the largest multi-coloured Sharps mosque pictorial its nearest/ next high @ £1,180. The Liverpool Bon Marche pictorial made a hefty £1,060, same price as the Manchester & Bolton Burgon elephant pictorial, whilst the tinted background Albarose, bonnetted girl pictorial, just behind @ £1,000. There were plenty of other strong lid performers too in this category.

**Soft & hard drinks:** Gingers, minerals & whisky stuff were all overshadowed by the exceptional, ultra rare, Doulton artware Greenlees brothers offering, with metal neck & lid, chased by a number of specialist connoisseurs but won, on the floor, for £5,200. Best 2 coloured minerals were the pale green Sittingbourne codd £730 & the 10oz amber Skinners Cods Patent 4 £590. The rare Walworth (man killing boar pict) hybrid was much chased to £440. Later the mini 4 mini Barnard codd (given to a young Barnsley glassworks apprentice as a lad) had lots keen to acquire but won for £770 by the same minis collector who also took away the rare Swansea r.r. mini g.b @ £295.

**Early stuff:** A seeming innocuous tradesmans sample chimney pot (1st we've ever offered) was much fancied/ chased to £550. No sealed shaft & globes this time round but a delightfully iridescent onion type made a solid £380 & a lovely looking pictorial sealed mallet, with rear repair, £470.
