"A fairy tale week-end - still walkin' on air"

More stalls than any previous Autumn Extravaganza, attendance up - more than 35%, a 'buzz' and friendly atmosphere both days, never had so many telephone calls "thanks for a super show"? Adverts stated 'Saturday Unreserved, Blg 21' still folk tootled to Milton hall - old habits die hard? Much discontent over hall caterers closing at 2pm - just as folk wanted a bite to eat and drink for 'round 2' of the 500 lot auction marathon - other site caterers reported an "afternoon deluge"! BBR displayed amended condition descriptions for lots reported different to catalogue wording - thank you to all who pointed these issues out helps everyone. AB announced a serious issue regarding reported 'threats' to folk bidding against them. This will in no way be tolerated - three names are 'in the hat', hear such again and we will name, shame and ban them. Attempted auction fixing is serious, albeit difficult to prove in a court of law. When your own collection is disposed how would you feel at your family getting half its worth? Autumn sun heralded the Sun. main 'bout' - everyone well behaved and orderly, new BBR member Jack made no errors keeping Early entrants to bang on 8.30 - the hall deluged with eager collectors, then 11am the catal'd sale, another splendid broad range across most every area.

Herewith some Sunday results, with add-ons:

Pot lids: The fabulous Edinburgh building pictorial was the highlight at the sale start, at £1,420, and the blue print flat topped 'Price & Gosnell' coming in a near second for £1,060. The Rugby building pictorial seemed a snip at £260 - no reports of unnoticed damage?

Minerals: Hamiltons defo' 'hot' - sml blue 'Elands/ Newcastle' £755, dark aqua 'Schweppes' £540. The real surprise here was the competition, and result, for the fabulous Morpeth pictorial beer - £770 - classic AB estimate '£20-30+?'

G.b's: After a dearth of such recently we presented a very, very fine spread - headlined by an all time N.E. 'classic', dog pictorial 'Everton's, £1,000 (Kevin Boyle Coll'n) with the best Scottish performer, sml c.c. 'D Kelly sailing ship pict. £615 (Ian McKenzie Coll'n). Some spirited bidding in this group!

Inks: Another impressive array primarily from Henry Horne & Norman Lewis Coll'ns - the aqua tortoise sheared lip figural led the field - £640, the ultra rare cobalt ribbed Blackwood & Co £190.

Miniatures: Bourne & Son/ Denby mini g.b's found favour: £425 (tan) & £400 (all white) respectively.

Kitchenalia: The Wingrave Anchovy pot (St Pauls pict.) was by far the tastiest morsal hereabouts at £1,475, but the mustards were equally keenly (?) chased - the blue top Batty £710 & the straight sided 'Yarmouth Bloater Paste' £380.

Advertising: Still strong ("enamels sound as a pound" commented one collector) with the Fry's five boys a firm favourite £1,180, the colourful Johnnie Walker £660. The pair of Fry's with raised shields performed according to rarity/ desirability (?) the Cocoa £650, the Chocolate £320. Two large animal pictorials held their own - Kositos £380, the Thorley's horse pict. £310. Hiding amongst the back bar gathering were 3 rarities... barring AB's estimate the pair of 'Walker's Brown Peter Ale' bears found a new home for £480, and the Guinness (caged toucan) £260, & 'Dahlia Tonica' £270. Loch Allan striker £240 - pushed to maximum postal bid, but still the only recorded example? The Teignmouth blue and whites all went 'home' - Exeter jug £425, Teignmouth tankard £355. The Penistone jug was contested by family descendants - winning it for £285 against a Penistone bottle collector. But the star here was the recently discovered 'Old Dad' pict. beer jug with 4 contenders lined up - won @ £1,300.

Pipes: Normans pipes continue thro' (& for some time - more Nov). 2 lots chased to £210 & £190.

Cures/ Poisons/ Pharmacy: Methinks most would struggle to comprehend final outcomes in this category, but so very strong all round! Top spot went to the illustrious 'smokey green blue' Ige Handysides £1,950, second place to the 2 pint (deep amber) London Warners £650. The 3 skulls all had 'issues' but performed as expected of such 'world classics' (rarely offered, keenly contested) - Ige £1,005, med £1,180, sml £825. But all were outshone & faught hard for by the ultra rarity in the form of the offset sheared lip Reeves - AB's estimate a tad out (£150-200+) secured by a determined London collector for £2,005, whilst the half ounce Martins encountered a fierce battle - finally falling for £825.

Early stoneware: Despite the pictures wrongly attributed to the 4 mason's mallets they were very much chased - the Speymouth £850 and the Old Monkland £910. Bertiebottles sweated until near the end, but successfully carried home the delightful Gt Yarmouth hip flask - a bargain £295?

Black glass: From the black glass (more in November & next year) finest performer was the attractive wide necked Nailsea jar - £710, the large 'H Hopper/ 1786' cylinder £380.

Heads already down finalising Novembers auction only spread, and gathering a sumptuous Winter feast for January 25 & 26th to ensure a successful BBR WinterNational to kickstart 2014.
