

All the stresses & headaches prior to a SummerNational are well & truly forgotten once the Saturday Early Entry queue descends hungrily upon the myriad of inside & outside stalls. Camping was boosted enormously with the Mediterranean weather, but by w/e end the much anticipated auction 'grand finale' concluded an undoubted out & out resounding SummerNational success?

Herewith a selection of higher fliers with 'add-ons' to show exact costs: Pot lids: It was dubbed the 'Pot Lid SummerNational' given the major Pot Lid book launch & bevy of 33 pot lid beauties in the auction. The 'choice' Washington Crossing the Delaware' @ £3,895 kickstarted proceedings, secured by a telephone bidder (a world record for a pot lid at a UK Bottle Show auction), the River Thames found 'dinky bear' was not far behind at £3,190, same price too for the Bury building pictorial. Three lids over £3k, & another four over £1,000!

Ginger beers: Been a dearth of top enders in this field for a while, the side chipped Economic (stunning sharp transfer) £1,770, blue print Sangs of Elgin £650, std, t.t. Bermondsey Spa Beverage £495, black glass Clapham £355, Blackburn dog pict. slab seal £1,000.

Minerals: A particularly juicey offering: Birmingham cobalt blue Goffes £9,090 (record for a UK col'd mineral at a public bottle auction?), Falkland (Fife) blue lip £3,780 (another record breaker?), Southampton dumpy green codd £1,030, Cambridge green Premier patent £1,000, St Ives stoneware hamilton £885.

Kitchenalia: Dundee Ammonia £470, Green top Northallerton cream pot £470, Ige Sleaford blue top cream £380, Finest Dairy Buttercrock £440.
